

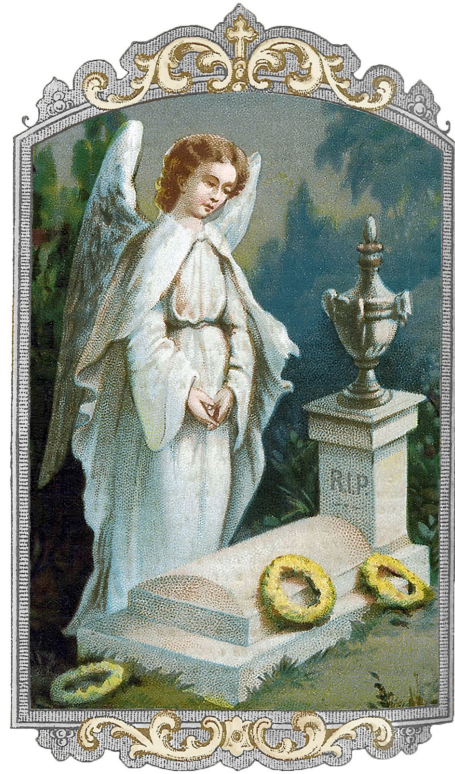
PRAYERS WHEN VISITING A CEMETERY
